### Seedlings

We have been learning about growing and have planted our own vegetables. The children enjoyed scooping and pouring the soil using tools. They have been developing their pretend play skills by washing the babies. The children followed instructions and named body parts. This week, we have visited the library and Farmfoods.

### Wednesday oth July- Leavers Farm Trip
