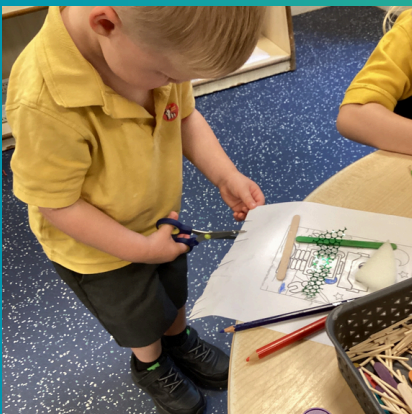

Seedlings

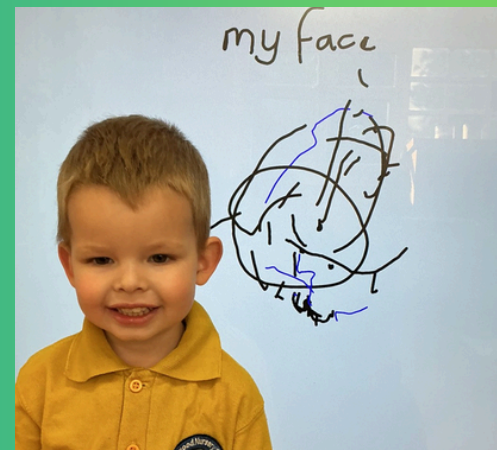
